

MINUTES
THORNBURY TOWNSHIP (CHESTER COUNTY)
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MEETING
Wednesday, December 14, 2011

Present: Chris Lang (chair), Anne Dzamba, Molly Morrison, Kris Walker, Dick Webster.

1. Approval of Minutes
The commission approved the minutes of October 12, 2011, as amended.
2. Quorum Policy
The commission unanimously agreed that three constitute a quorum of members.
3. New Commission Members
The commission recommends Randell Spackman to the Board of Supervisors as a member of the commission for a full term. Dick Webster will ask the township secretary to insert a notice in *The Gander*, requesting that residents interested in serving on the commission submit a letter of intent and a resume to the township. He also will request an email blast to serve the same purpose.
4. Sign for Distinctive Dentistry
The zoning officer, who determined that the proposed sign does not meet ordinance requirements, is awaiting a response from Distinctive Dentistry.
5. Squire Cheyney Property
Orleans is expected to transfer title, without a subdivision provision, December 20. Molly Morrison updated the commission on the Ad Hoc Committee's work and shared Dale Frens's memo on what should be addressed in an easement. Molly has contacted various organizations about holding the easement; none is eager to do so. Georgiana Hannum recommends marketing via "grapevine" rather than using conventional marketing techniques.
6. Historic Preservation Commission Articles for *The Gander*
Anne Dzamba has submitted an article about Green Shadows (Galantino residence), for the December issue of *The Gander*.
7. Oral History Project
Chris Lange will interview Peter Galantino and Frank Hash in the next few weeks.
