**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP (CHESTER COUNTY)
HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION
Minutes of MEETING on Wednesday, March 10, 2010**

Members present: Anne Dzamba, Chris Lang (chair), Molly Morrison.
Webster had given Lang his input in advance.

1. Approval of minutes

The Commission accepted the minutes of February 3rd, written by Dick Webster.

2. Membership vacancy

There is still one vacancy on the commission. J. Werry, a prospective member, is moving out of the township. Members suggested other possibilities.

3. Cheyney Farmstead

Chris reported that on March 12th, a meeting of B. Brody, T. Spackman, M. Gast, and the township's attorney will take place to review all documents regarding Orleans, Dallett, and the township and to chart a course of action.

It was noted that we have not heard from the BOS regarding our motion of February 3rd to take action now to stabilize and protect the barn.

4. Historic Resources Survey Project

The HPC members discussed their reviews of the survey forms. The discussion resulted in the formation of a subcommittee of Lang, Webster, and Walker to meet with Jane Dorchester on the incorporation of corrections and revisions to the surveys. Supplemental cultural information will not be included in this discussion.

5. Comprehensive Plan review

Chris Lang reviewed the process for the Comprehensive Plan amendment. The Planning Commission voted on March 8th to recommend approval to the Board. The HPC discussed reviewed the Plan Recommendations in the draft pg 7-1 to 7-3. The HPC (including Dick Webster's approval) approved recommending to the Board adopting this amendment to the Comprehensive Plan.

6. Township oral history project

It was noted that T. Spackman is looking into recording equipment; that the book on oral history Webster ordered by the township has arrived; and that Kris Walker has suggested that together we formulate the key questions we need to ask interviewees. Further discussion was tabled until our April 14th meeting.
