1. Purpose of the Meeting

The meeting was convened to consider Scott Megill's request for a demolition permit for 4 Huntrise Lane.

The commission did not receive Mr. Megill's feasibility study until its members arrived at the meeting, seriously limiting the ability to read and examine its contents. Mr. Megill's presentation included his summary of his feasibility study for 4 Huntrise Lane, and in particular the tenant house and barn on that property. Near the end of his presentation, he indicated that he would be willing to discuss options regarding the future of the barn and the tenant house. Judy Lizza clarified his willingness to sell the property to the township.

To give the commission and the Board of Supervisors time to discuss and evaluate the proposals and options, Mr. Megill agreed to an extension of deliberations until October 10, 2018.

Motion: Accept an extension for consideration of the request for a demolition permit for 4 Huntrise Lane until October 10, 2018.
