

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES March 19, 2019**

CALL TO ORDER:

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Jim Benoit - Chairman at 6:15 PM in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Mike Gallagher, and Bob Anthony. Judy Lizza, Township Manager, Teresa DeStefano, Township Secretary and Kathy Labrum, Township Solicitor, were also in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted by Jim Benoit.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Jim Benoit motioned to approve the February 19, 2019 Board of Supervisors Minutes and the March 5, 2019 Work Session Meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Mike Gallagher. All were in favor. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Frank Speidel, 215 William Penn Blvd wanted to know the Boards policy on damaged mailboxes during a snow storm. The Board listened to his concerns and will have the manager sent a copy of the Township's Policy on Snow.

MANAGER'S REPORT:

Judy Lizza mention that Mike Conrad will be getting the road inspections completed this month.

AGENDA BUSINESS:

1. Road Maintenance Contract Renewal: Neff Construction

Jim Benoit moved to extend the Road Maintenance Contract to Neff Construction, Inc. Seconded by Mike Gallagher. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Jim Benoit moved to approve Resolution 2019-12: Chester County Grant Resolution and Resolution 2019-13: PA DCNR (Department of Conservation and Natural Resources) Seconded by Mike Gallagher. All were in favor. Motion carried.

4. Discussion of the Brandywine Battlefield Connectivity Plan with the Brandywine Conservancy, Birmingham, East Bradford, Westtown, Pennsbury, Kennett, and Chadds Ford Townships.

Jim Benoit noted that Thornbury Township is interested in partnering in the multi-municipal planning effort led by Brandywine Conservancy. Jim Benoit moved to endorse the Vision Partnership grant application; having the Township Manager draft the letter of endorsement for Thornbury Township's commitment to the Brandywine Battlefield Heritage Interpretation Plan. Seconded by Bob Anthony. All were in favor. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:


