

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORK SESSION**

MINUTES – June 4, 2019

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:15 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Jim Benoit Chairman, Bill Reilly and Michael Gallagher. Also, in attendance were Judy Lizza, Township Manager; Teresa DeStefano, Township Secretary and Kathy Labrum Township Solicitor.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. 2019 Road Program award contractor

Jim Benoit noted that Thornbury Township has bid out the following roads for paving Crop Court, Four-In-Hand Court, Pony Court, Sidesaddle Place, Timberline Trail, Woodhaven Road, and a section of Old Bailey Lane (Twaddell intersection to #332). The Township budgeted \$220,000 and received from Penn DOT Liquid Fuels \$121,449.38. Two bids were received for the 2019 Road program: A.F. Damon and Innovative Construction Services (INNCON). The lowest responsible bidder was INNCON.

Jim Benoit move to award the 2019 Road Program to INNCON in the amount of \$227,776.96. The motion was seconded by Mike Gallagher. All in favor. Motion carried.

OTHER MATTERS:

1. Randell Spackman to discuss possible new venture at Thornbury farm

Randell Spackman came to speak to the board regarding some changes and improvements to the Farm. Randell would like to have a Beer Garden with old style beers, keeping with historic feel of the farm. There would be limited operating hours and will keep with the theme of Historic Resources.

2. Eagle Scout Mr. Streit came to the Township meeting to get information on how government works and start working on his Eagle Scout Project.
3. Judy Lizza mentioned that the West Chester Fire Department has invited the Supervisors to attend a drill night and will coordinate schedules for attendance.
4. Judy also noted that she has gotten information and pricing on the Speed Signs and the Emergency barricades. She will email the price sheet for the boards review.
