MINUTES – August 6, 2019

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:15 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Jim Benoit Chairman, Bob Anthony Vice Chairman, Bill Reilly, Joe Lisa and Michael Gallagher. Also, in attendance were Judy Lizza, Township Manager and Kathy Labrum, Township Solicitor.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. *Extension for Snow Removal for Township – Andrew's Landscaping*

Thornbury Township has a contract with Andrew's Landscaping for Township snow removal. This extension would be the 2<sup>nd</sup> of five years. It was agreed to extend the contract.

2. *Snow Removal for Town Center Contract*

Kathy Labrum will draft a new contract for the snow removal of the Town Center. This item does not need to be bid since it is below the bidding threshold.

3. *2019 Budget Review*

Judy Lizza updated the Board on the 2019 Budget. All revenues and expenditures are as budgeted. Anticipating the 2020 Budget to be similar with basic increases as warranted by contracts.

4. *Westtown Township Zoning Hearing Board Application, August 29<sup>th</sup> 6:30PM at Westtown Township Municipal Bldg.: WCASD requesting an increase for the allowance of outdoor field lighting from 20 days to 30 days.*

Announcement for public knowledge.

5. *County Wide Act 167 Stormwater Plan and Ordinance Update*

Discussion of the costs this update will place on the Township.

**OTHER MATTERS:**

1. Brian Carickhoff, 100 Spur Lane, requested "Local Traffic Only" signage for Brandywine at Thornbury. Concerned with volume of traffic that continues to cut through the community. Discussion that the signs are unenforceable.
2. Wayne Sweinhart, 217 Red Lion Road, wanted to know if there is an exemption to the septic pumping requirements.


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ADJOURNMENT:
