- Aqua would like to build a shed to house pumps, etc. at S. New St. HPC was reluctant to say yes to this request as it sits in the Brandywine Battlefield. Judy to communicate our views to the Brandywine Conservancy which holds the conservation easement.
- 4 Huntrise is presenting plans to the Planning Commission to request a variance. HPC to provide a brief narrative of support of the proposed plan (ie location of garage) and reaffirm our engagement in choice of final materials when going for building permits. Meeting is set for June 22 at 7pm and Judy will send out an invite for the virtual meeting.
- Toll is requesting a public meeting for the S. New St. intersection. Michele to reach out to members of BBPA for letters of strong support and general opposition to the enlarged intersection
- 2020 Thornbury Days has been cancelled
- 2026 Celebrations. Agenda topic to remain active, as we think of ideas on how to celebrate the upcoming sesquicentennial both as a township as a part of Chester County.
- Nancy suggested that South Concord might want to be a state byway. She will follow up with some additional research.
- Judy spoke to one of the members of Westtown Historic Commission who would like to have an informal meeting with us. Judy to set up virtual meeting, if majority of members are interested.
