

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES April 20, 2021**

CALL TO ORDER:

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Jim Benoit at 6:15 PM. In attendance were Supervisors Jim Benoit, Robert Anthony, Robert Wiggins, Michael Gallagher, and Joseph Lisa. Judy Lizza, Township Manager, Teresa Destefano, Township Secretary, Mike Conrad, Township Engineer, and Kathy Labrum, Township Solicitor were in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted by Jim Benoit.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Jim Benoit motioned to approve the March 16, 2021 Board of Supervisors Meeting minutes and the April 6, 2021 Work Session minutes. The motion was seconded by Bob Anthony. All were in favor. Motion carried.

MANAGER'S REPORT:

Judy Lizza presented the Manager's report; a copy is on file.

Mike Conrad presented the 2021 Road Program for the Boards' review.

Judy Lizza highlighted a few items.

- Top of Timberline Trail, storm water runoff.
- Southgate Road, Pipe replacement near 1260.
- Rich Acciavatti came into the PC with his sketch plan and proposed 25 independent units. The commission had a few concerns.
- There are two applications in May for the ZHB.
- There are three Eagle Scout projects upcoming.
- Gov. Wolf did extended the State personal income tax until May 17, 2021
- DEP received a report for dumping into the storm drains at 173 Lydia Lane.

AGENDA BUSINESS:

1. Aqua Pump Station located on S. New Street Motion for Renovations

Regarding the renovations of the Aqua pump station, Jim Benoit moves to recommend the following:

- The existing pumps will be replaced, remaining in the existing vaults.
- The panels associated would be replaced; all underground.
- The generator is currently located out of the easement. If and when the generator needs to be replaced or upgraded, it shall be relocated within the easement.
- The fencing shall be removed. All equipment shall be painted as to blend with the area. Suggested color ---Rust-Oleum Universal 11 oz.

All Surface Hammered Chestnut or Dark Bronze Spray Paint and Primer in One

- An area for a pull off for Aqua vehicles may be constructed off the shoulder while remaining in the easement. The pull off shall be constructed at Aqua's expense and be made of grass pavers.
- There may be some vegetation that may be needed to be removed. It is requested that holly bushes be planted to provide a natural buffer. **Joe Lisa seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.**
