RESOLUTION 2022-11

A RESOLUTION OF THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FOR APPROVAL OF AN ACT 537 OFFICIAL PLAN REVISION

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection ("PADEP") adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Township to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards and to revise that Plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Township; and

WHEREAS, Thornbury Township has been requested to approve the Act 537 Plan modification promulgated by Birmingham Township, that affects only that portion of the Township occupied by the Shoppes at Dilworthtown Crossing.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved that the Township hereby adopts and submits to the PADEP for its approval, as a revision to the "Official Plan" of Thornbury Township, the Act 537 Planning Special Study which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Special Study").

The Township hereby approves and adopts the Special Study, which provides the basis to implement the selected alternative for the sale of the Birmingham Township's sanitary sewer system (collection, conveyance, and treatment) to Bucks County Water and Sewer Authority.




